Come and join us for the day for a guided tour of the well-known Bletchley Park near Milton Keynes, home to the famous Enigma code-breaking machine in World War II.

Following refreshments on arrival, the first part of the visit will take approximately 1¼ hours and includes a tour of the outside of the wartime buildings where we will be given a detailed history of the site and its codebreaking activities. After lunch (Cottage Pie or Vegetarian Lasagne), 'A World War Two Evacuee's Story' starts the second part of the tour which includes a visit to B Block museum which tells the complete Bletchley Park Story. Tea and time to visit the shop or revisit parts of the site conclude the day.
