I regret to inform you that Dr Kong Luk, elected as representative of NRPSI Interpreters on the NRPSI Review Panel, has announced his resignation from the panel with immediate effect, and has circulated, through various e-mail forums and discussion groups, a statement of his resignation and the reasons for it.

The Working Group responsible for developing the terms of reference for the review, and for appointing the panel, regrets Dr Luk's decision but is grateful for his input to the review so far.

The panel has received submissions from interested parties and stakeholders, including NRPSI-registered interpreters and CIOL members, many of whom have contributed their views. The work of the panel is almost completed, and it will submit its report for consideration by Council at its scheduled meeting on Saturday, 28th November.
