Languages on Demand
Core Languages

In order to allow us to set our examination papers in the most timely and economically viable way possible, languages will be divided into Languages on Demand and Core Languages with effect from 2010.

Languages on Demand will be set if there are sufficient numbers (i.e. a minimum of 3 candidates per language/option). Candidates can pay a supplementary fee to have the paper set for one or two candidates only, but may need to travel to London for the Oral Units.

Candidates wishing to enter for one of the **Languages on Demand** should send their entry cards to the Central Registration Department by **31 January 2010**.

Candidates will be informed by the end of February whether there is sufficient demand to set the paper in their particular language/option.

Core Languages & options are offered every year.

The candidate entry deadline for **Core Languages** is **28 February 2010**.

Please consult the language list to see which deadline applies to your language and option.

If the Institute is unable to locate examiners to carry out the examination, it reserves the right to withdraw the examination. In such cases candidates' fees will be refunded but the IoLET will not be liable for any additional expenditure candidates may have incurred.
