## Re: The Metropolitan Police Test

Thank you for taking an interest in The Metropolitan Police Test conducted by the Institute of Linguists Educational Trust. The Institute in conjunction with the Metropolitan Police Service has created a test that will lead to a public service interpreting qualification that is recognised by the National Register of Public Service Interpreters (NRPSI Ltd).

The assessment currently costs £555.00 and the London centre fee costs £115.00 (revised every academic year). The Metropolitan Police Test runs twice a year. There is a session in the Winter (November) and the Summer (May/June).

If you are interested in taking the test, please complete the enclosed registration card and return it to IoLET, together with a cheque for the test fee and centre fee as applicable, made payable to the IoL Educational Trust. If you wish to pay by card, please submit your form first and then call the office to process your payment over the phone.

If you would like to take the test in more than one language (maximum of 2 languages per session), please complete a separate registration card for each language. More registration cards can be obtained from IoLET.

If, by the deadline for each round of assessments (contact our office for details of deadlines), you are the only person who wishes to sit a test in your particular chosen language, you can choose either to pay an additional Single Candidate Supplement fee of £200.00 in order to take the test in that session (this would be refunded to you if a subsequent application was made that could be accommodated) or you may defer to the next round of assessments.

An order form for the purchase of past papers is also included in this pack. Please ensure that you read the Candidate Briefing Sheet for each of the six components carefully. Please also note that candidates are required to pass all components of the test to be awarded an overall pass. If a candidate fails any of the components, re-sits are available per component – please see additional sheet for re-sit fees.

Please make sure that you read the Candidate Regulations before applying for the Metropolitan Police Test.
